

UCAT ANZ 2019 Summary Test Statistics



The following table of summary statistics of the scaled scores for UCAT ANZ 2019 should assist you to understand your results in relation to those of other candidates.

The scaled score range for each cognitive subtest (and the SJT) is 300 – 900 and the range for the Total Score (sum of the four cognitive subtests) is 1200 – 3600.

The 1st decile represents a score at the 10th percentile; the 2nd decile represents a score at the 20th percentile, and so on.
