
UCAT ANZ 2021 – Booking your Test

1. Dashboard


Login to your <u>Pearson VUE account</u> to book your test. Click on 'UCAT ANZ: UCAT Australia and New Zealand'.



2. Exam Details

'View Testing Policies', click Next.

NOTE: Australian candidates who are named on a current Health Care Card/ Pensioner Concession Card (issued by Centrelink) are eligible for the reduced test fee (<u>Concession Scheme</u>) and must apply at the UCAT ANZ website **before** booking their test. If you book your test before receiving your concession voucher you will pay the full fee.



3. Additional Questions from UCAT – Australia and New Zealand

The UCAT ANZ Consortium seeks to minimise bias due to factors such as age, gender, nationality, ethnicity or socio-economic background. In order to do this, we collect demographic, admissions and educational data on applicants to medical and dental schools in Australia and New Zealand.

The data collected below provides the Consortium with an effective, reliable mechanism for the administration of the test, the verification of the fairness and internal reliability of the test and allows the UCAT ANZ Consortium to undertake research related to admissions to medicine and dentistry.

Research and analysis only take place on anonymised data and the Consortium is committed to ensuring that no individuals or groups can be identified in any published research undertaken on its behalf. Eligibility The UCAT ANZ is only available to a candidate whose educational level at the time of sitting the test is that they are undertaking or have completed the final year of secondary school, or higher. Students in Australian Year 11 or lower are NOT eligible to sit the UCAT ANZ. Any person having an affiliation with a UCAT coaching business, for example, in their capacity as a tutor, or as an item developer, or having some financial interest in a UCAT coaching business will not be eligible to sit the UCAT ANZ. You are required to agree in order to proceed to book your test. Candidates registering for UCAT ANZ 2021 should have completed, or plan to COMPLETE their final year of secondary schooling in 2021, that is, Year 12 in Australia or Year 13 in New Zealand. Candidates are eligible to sit the test if they have commenced or completed an undergraduate degree. It is noted, however that not all the undergraduate degree programs for which UCAT ANZ is a prerequisite will offer places for non-school leavers. Candidates are advised to check the UCAT ANZ Consortium university websites for further information. Only a limited number of UCAT ANZ Consortium universities require international students to sit the UCAT ANZ and, if so, it will only be required in specific circumstances. 

Select up to three test centres to compare availability by checking the box next to the test centre. 'Click Next'.



 (You will confirm and submit the details of your booking and payment on the next page.)


