

## Interim statistics for UCAT ANZ 2021

The following table shows interim statistics for UCAT ANZ 2021, for the 12 723 candidates who sat the test from July 1 to September 12, 2021.

\*The 1<sup>st</sup> decile is at the 10<sup>th</sup> percentile, the second at the 20<sup>th</sup> percentile etc. Hence the 5<sup>th</sup> decile shows the median score.

The final version of this information will be provided in early October to show statistics for all 2021 testing. Given the large number of candidates represented in this table and the cross-section of candidates represented, we do not expect final figures to differ much from those presented here.
