
## **UCAT ANZ 2022 – Booking your Test**

#### 1. Dashboard


Login to your <u>Pearson VUE account</u> to book your test. Click on 'UCAT ANZ: UCAT Australia and New Zealand'.



#### 2. Exam Details

'View Testing Policies', click Next.

NOTE: Australian candidates who are named on a current Health Care Card/ Pensioner Concession Card (issued by Centrelink) are eligible for the reduced test fee (<u>Concession Scheme</u>) and must apply at the UCAT ANZ website **before** booking their test. If you book your test before receiving your concession voucher you will pay the full fee.



### 3. Additional Questions from UCAT - Australia and New Zealand

The UCAT ANZ Consortium seeks to minimise bias due to factors such as age, gender, nationality, ethnicity or socio-economic background. In order to do this, we collect demographic, admissions and educational data on applicants to medical and dental schools in Australia and New Zealand.



The nearest test centres and their approximate distance will be shown.


Select up to three test centres to compare availability by checking the box next to the test centre. 'Click Next'.



## **Choose Appointment**

Ensure you are looking at the month of July 2022. Some test centres will have dates available up to 12 August. If no test dates are showing then the test centre has reached capacity and you will need to select another test centre.



6. Available test appointments for the date you have selected will be shown.





NOTE: these policies are included in the confirmation email you will receive when you have successfully booked your test. The information is available at the <u>UCAT ANZ website</u>.






# **Enter Payment and billing**

 (You will confirm and submit the details of your booking and payment on the next page.)


NOTE: Candidates with a concession voucher should click the 'Add Voucher or Promo Code' link to access the reduced test fee.
