# Agree to UCAT – Australia and New Zealand policies

## UCAT - Australia & New Zealand policies

Read and Agree to the terms and conditions. This information is also provided in your booking confirmation email, Pearson VUE account and at the UCAT ANZ website.

### Terms and Conditions

**Important:** Health and safety protocols may differ by test center and/or region. Please go to the [Pearson VUE COVID-19 Update web page](#) frequently and the day before your exam to review the latest vaccination and face mask policies and other health and safety measures required at your test center.

By scheduling your test appointment, you agree to comply with these requirements. You will be asked to acknowledge these conditions and requirements upon arrival at the test center.

### Admission Policy

You must arrive at the test centre at least 30 minutes before your scheduled appointment time. This will give you adequate time to complete the necessary sign-in procedures. If you arrive more than 15 minutes after your appointment time you will be refused admission. If you are refused admission due to late arrival, you will forfeit the exam appointment and test fees. You will have to phone [Pearson VUE Customer Services](#) to book and pay for a new test on another day (subject to availability of appointments). This applies in cases of family emergency, accident, transport problems and security alert as well as forgetfulness and lateness.

### Identification and Documentation

You must bring **BOTH** of the following documents with you:

- A printed or electronic copy of your **appointment confirmation email** from Pearson VUE
- **One piece of photographic identification** from the list below which meets the requirements of the country where you are testing. You must present the original ID (not a photocopy, photo or digital ID) and it must be valid (unexpired).

### Passport

An original, valid passport that contains a recognisable photo.

### Driver's licence

A government issued original, valid licence that contains a recognisable photo will **ONLY** be accepted at test centres in the country of issue. You may present a learner's permit, probationary or full licence. A digital licence will not be accepted.

### Australian Keypass Card

An original, valid [Keypass Card / Keypass Under 18 Card](#) that contains a recognisable photo. A digital Keypass will not be accepted. The Keypass is issued by Australia Post.

### Australian Proof of Age Card

A government issued original, valid [Australian Proof of Age Card](#) that contains a recognisable photo. Only the following Proof of Age Cards from each state or territory are accepted:

### New Zealand 18+ / Kiwi Access Card

An original, valid New Zealand [18+ / Kiwi Access Card](#) that contains a recognisable photo. The Kiwi Access Card has replaced the 18+ Card and is issued by New Zealand Post.



### **Important information about ID**

We take the security of the test very seriously, therefore test centre staff have no discretion to waive or vary the ID rules. If you cannot obtain acceptable ID before your test date, you will need to reschedule to a later date when you will have the correct form of ID, subject to availability of test appointments. See the [Rescheduling and Cancelling](#) page of our website.

**If you need to update your name on your account to match your ID, you must call [Pearson VUE Customer Services](#) at least 5 business days before your test appointment to seek advice.**

Your name and date of birth on your ID MUST exactly match the name and date of birth you provided when you registered otherwise your ID will not be accepted. If it does not match you must contact Pearson VUE Customer Services at least 5 business days before your appointment in order that this can be addressed.

Student ID cards/ employer ID cards, bus/ train passes and library cards will NOT be accepted under any circumstances.

If you arrive without the correct ID, or the name on your account and identification do not match, you will not be able to sit the test. You will lose your test fee and you will have to pay for a new test appointment on another day. This will be difficult towards the end of testing when availability of test appointments will be limited.

### **Reschedule Policy**

Tests can be rescheduled without charge as long as you give appropriate notice. If you miss the deadline for rescheduling, you will need to pay the test fee again to rebook.

You can reschedule your test through your [Pearson VUE account](#) up to 24 hours before your test appointment time.

If you miss the deadline for rescheduling for any reason, you will not be eligible for a refund or a free reschedule. You must wait for your appointment status to change to a 'no-show' status (usually 24 hours). You will then be able to book another appointment at your own cost by calling [Pearson VUE Customer Services](#).

Rescheduling is subject to the availability of appointments. In some circumstances you may need to travel to another location if there are no available appointments at your preferred test location.

**IMPORTANT** - During the reschedule process, once you have selected a new appointment there are several more steps before the reschedule is confirmed. If you do not receive an email confirming the reschedule you have not gone through all the necessary steps.

You **cannot** reschedule or cancel an appointment by email.

### **Missed Tests (No-shows)**

If you miss your test for any reason, the appointment will count as a 'no-show' and you will not be eligible for a refund. The standard test fee will be charged to re-book your test.

This applies in cases of illness, family emergency, accident, arrest, transport problems and security alert as well as forgetfulness and lateness. It also applies to those who arrive at the test centre with inadequate/ invalid identification. Refer to [Rescheduling and Cancelling](#) for more information.

### **Cancellation Policy**

Tests can be cancelled for a refund by the cancellation deadline of 3 June 2022 (11:59pm AEST). A refund fee of \$50 will be deducted. The late fee is non-refundable.

If you miss the cancellation deadline of 3 June 2022 (11:59pm AEST), your test fee will not be refunded.

#### **Test Day**

#### **UCAT ANZ 'Fit to Test' Policy**

Candidates who present themselves to test are declaring themselves fit to take the test.

If you are aware of anything that might affect your performance on the day, you should not sit the test. This applies even if you fall ill or experience issues on the day of your test.

If you are not fit to test, you should reschedule your appointment to a later date, even if you have missed the rescheduling deadline and must pay the test fee again to rebook.

Do not attend a Pearson VUE Test Centre if you have any symptoms of COVID-19. Follow current government guidelines and reschedule your test to a later date, after any mandatory self-isolation period.

If you choose to sit your test against this advice, UCAT ANZ will not accept this as a mitigating circumstance.


