ABOUT THE TEST

The UCAT ANZ test is a 2-hour, multiple choice, computer-based test. It consists of four separately timed subtests which assess a range of abilities identified by university medical and dental schools as important.

VERBAL REASONING
DECISION MAKING
QUANTITATIVE REASONING
SITUATIONAL JUDGEMENT TEST

The test is delivered in Pearson VUE test centres throughout Australia and New Zealand, and at some overseas locations.

ELIGIBILITY

The test is only available to a candidate whose educational level at the time of sitting the test is that they are undertaking or have completed the final year of secondary schooling, or higher.

For example, candidates registering for UCAT ANZ 2025 should have completed, or plan to complete their final year of secondary schooling in 2025 (Year 12 in Australia; Year 13 in New Zealand).

HOW DO I BOOK A TEST?

Visit the UCAT ANZ website to book your test by 16 May 2025 at 11:59pm AEST. Refer to the Key Dates for late booking deadlines. No further bookings are accepted after the final booking deadline.

Note that you can only sit the test once a year.

PHOTO IDENTIFICATION

You are required to show one form of current photo identification at the test centre from the list below:

- **Passport**
- **Driver's Licence** (only accepted at test centres in country of issue)
- **Australian Proof of Age Card** (issued by each state or territory, only accepted in Australia)
- **New Zealand 18+ Card / Kiwi Access Card** (only accepted in New Zealand)
- **Hong Kong Identity Card** (only accepted in Hong Kong)
- **Singapore Identity Card** (only accepted in Singapore)

No other form of ID is accepted, including Student ID cards. Expired ID, photocopies, photos and digital forms of ID are not accepted.
